



The William Myers Section is outlined in green, superimposed over a map of the area for the year 2003.

The farm of Dr. John H. Stevens at the time of his death in 1881 is outlined in blue, with the family house shown as a blue dot (situated in modern Middlebrook Place).

In the 1870s Dr. Stevens bought the 80 acre parcel outlined in orange and then sold it to his father-in-law, Reverend Samuel Armstrong. Portions were slowly sold away and only 25 acres remained at the time of Reverend Armstrong's death in 1889. Though the exact site I never proved, the residence of Samuel Armstrong, his wife Eliza, and their son Dr. William Hora Armstrong seems to have been situated along Sylvan Avenue between the Fort Worth Pike (modern Fort Worth Avenue) and Coombes Creek, in the approximate vicinity indicated here as a red dot.

The family owned numerous other Dallas County land parcels not shown here.
